STEARNS COUNTY FEEDLOT PERMIT EXTENSION REQUEST

Some feedlot permit extensions must be requested at least 90 days prior to expiration of the permit. In other cases, the permit holder may ask for an extension within 90 days of the permit expiration if the permit has not expired. ***Permit holders must either complete the feedlot construction before the permit expires or apply for a new permit or extension prior to permit expiration.***

If there is no pollution potential or if the pollution potential has been corrected, a permit extension of up to 24 months *may be given*. If a pollution potential has *not* been corrected, an extension of up to 90 days *may be given*. Under no circumstance shall a feedlot be stocked with an animal expansion prior to the fulfillment of all permit conditions related to correction of the pollution hazard (7020.0535, subpart 8).

The following information must be provided by the permit holder in order to grant an extension, when an Interim Feedlot Permit was issued:

*Up to 24 months if no pollution potential exists, up to 90 days if pollution potential has not been corrected.

If the animal feedlot under construction or expansion will be capable of holding 500 animal units or more or the manure storage area under construction or expansion will be capable of holding manure produced by 500 animal units or more when completed, a notification required under 7020.2000 shall be submitted on a form provided by the Commissioner of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency. This notification shall also include the date on which the original permit was issued and the new proposed completion date.
